

Depart for the famous Hanoi <b>Train Street</b> where the old railway train runs mere inches away from the shops and residences. Enjoy drinks at the cafes by the tracks. After lunch, explore <b>Trang An Ecotourism Complex</b> by boat, passing through four natural caves: Hang Lám, Hang Vạng, Hang Thánh Trượt, and Hang Đại, and visit the Suoi Tien Temple and Vu Lam Palace. Visit the <b>St Joseph Cathedral</b> a late 19th-century Gothic Revival (Neo-Gothic style) church. Visit the <b>Ho Chi Minh's Mausoleum</b> and the <b>One Pillar Pagoda</b>.
